Blood donation camps

1. During the academic year 2019-2020, our college organized a blood donation camp on December 9, 2019, in association with Blood Donors Kerala. The event aimed to collect blood for hospitals and educate students about donating blood. Around 120 students registered for donation and more than 45 units of blood were collected. The blood donation camp was successful, demonstrating the college community's commitment to social responsibility and helping those in need. It was a day filled with kindness and generosity, leaving everyone involved feeling proud and accomplished



• On October 11, 2022, our college hosted a successful blood donation camp in collaboration with B.D.K Ponnani Taluk. The event took place in the college auditorium from 9 AM to 4 PM, with the primary goal of collecting blood for hospitals and patients in need. Donating blood can save lives, and it's a meaningful way for students and staff to contribute to the community. Over 126 students and staff members registered to donate blood, with 54 students successfully donating. Medical professionals were present to ensure the safety and comfort of the donors, while volunteers from the student body assisted in organizing the event and guiding donors. The event began with registration, followed by a health check-up conducted by medical staff to ensure donors were fit to give blood. After donating, participants received snacks and drinks to help them recover. The event raised awareness about the importance of blood donation, and many first-time donors expressed their willingness to donate again in the future.




