







Most respondents are very connected (33 out of 46) in the level of collaboration among faculty members within your department or discipline





Most respondents (17 out of 46) says that there are some lacking resources that the feel for enhancing your teaching effectiveness. 11 are neutral






The above chart shows that Most respondents says they face challenges in assessing students progress and performance

The above chart shows that Most respondents (30 out of 46) are satisfied with the balance between theoretical concepts and practical applications covered in the syllabus




Majority of the respondents (34 out of 46) are supported to the professional development opportunities related to teaching




